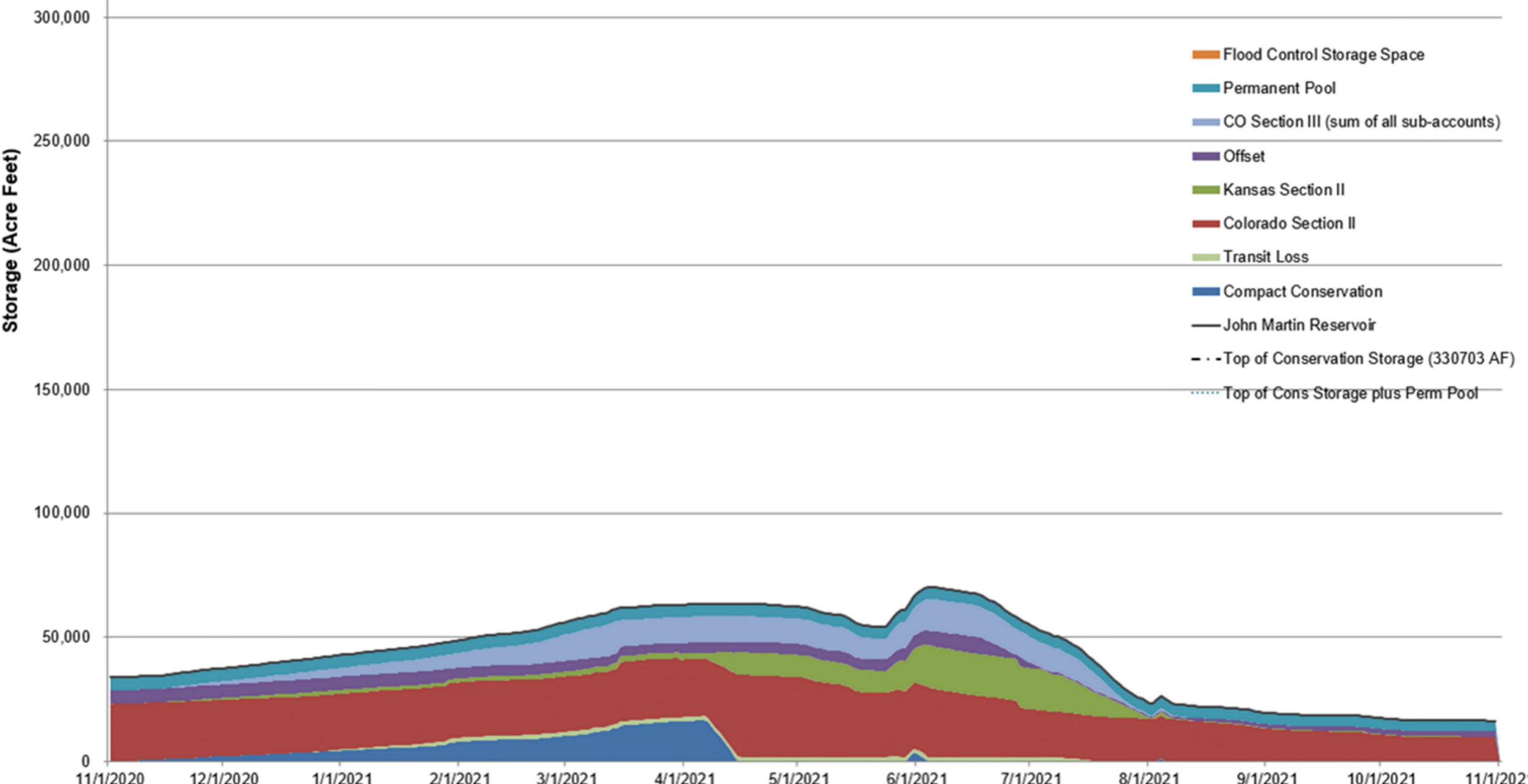

John Martin Storage Accounts





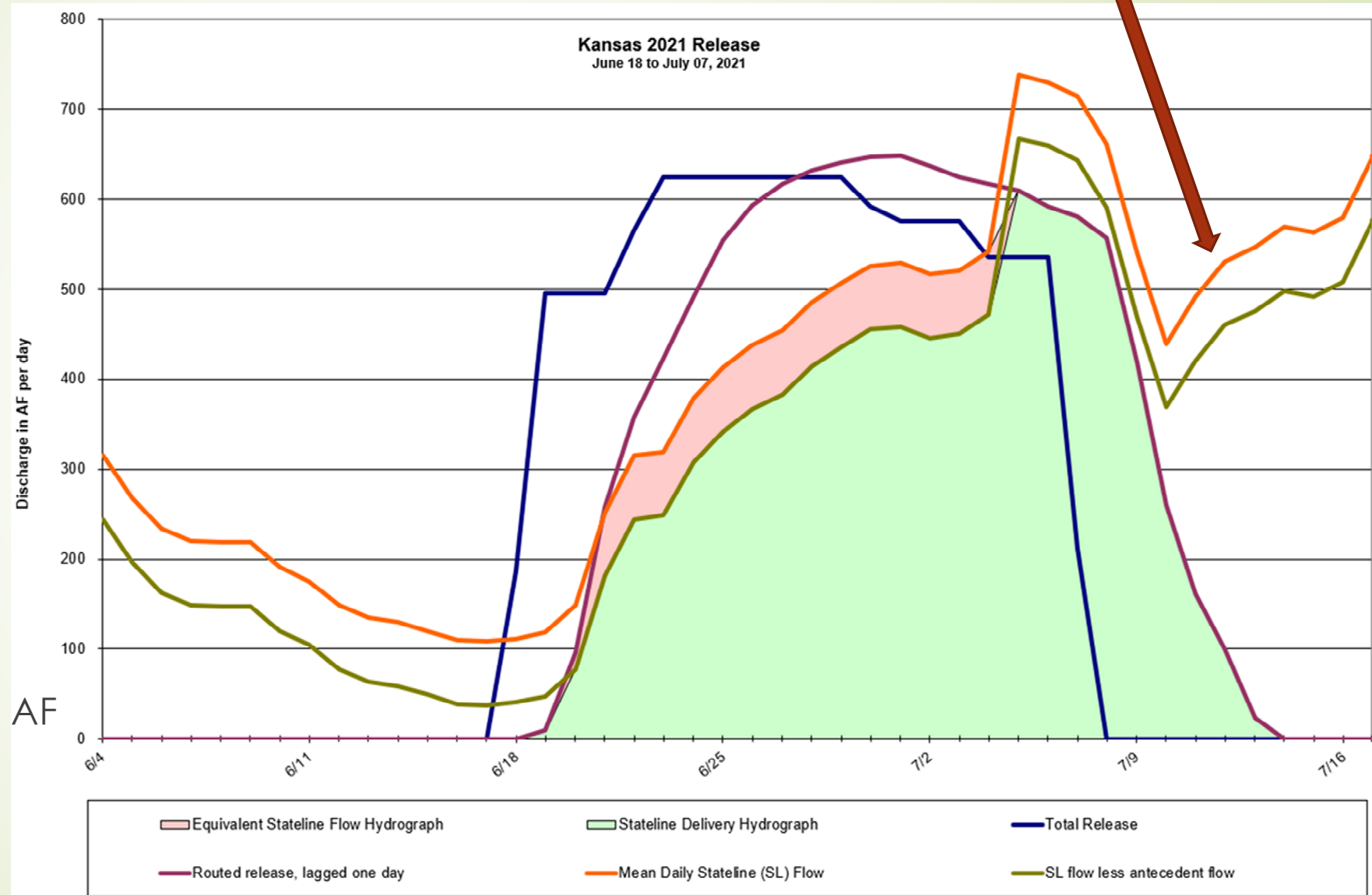
2020 AOS Report

- ▶ Kansas had two releases
 - ▶ First release from 6/18 to 7/7/2021
 - ▶ Second release 7/9 to 8/7/2021
 - ▶ States agreed to release accounting
 - ▶ Agreed to review how target flow at Granada is determined
- ▶ Focused on keeping Offset Account fully released

Stateline Delivery Quantities

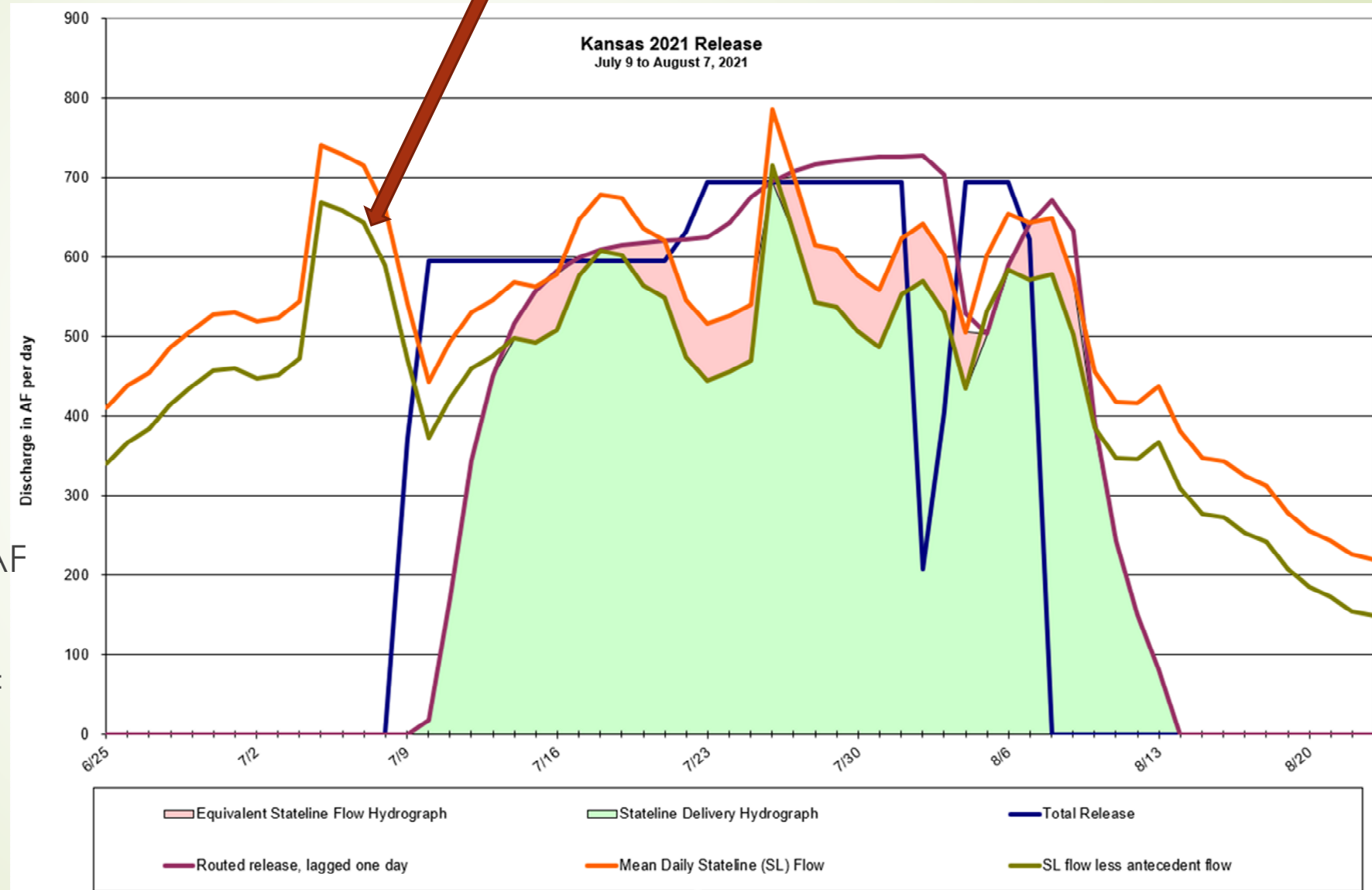
- Kansas Sec II Release
 - delivery – 1,354 AF
 - delivery deficit – 164 AF
- Offset Account delivery
 - Consumable – 7,711 AF
 - Nonconsumable – 1521 AF



Runoff event and end of Kansas 1st Release

Stateline Delivery Quantities

- ▶ Kansas Sec II Release
 - ▶ delivery – 16,674 AF
 - ▶ delivery deficit – 609 AF
- ▶ Offset Account delivery
 - ▶ Consumable – 1,122 AF
 - ▶ Nonconsumable – 0 AF
