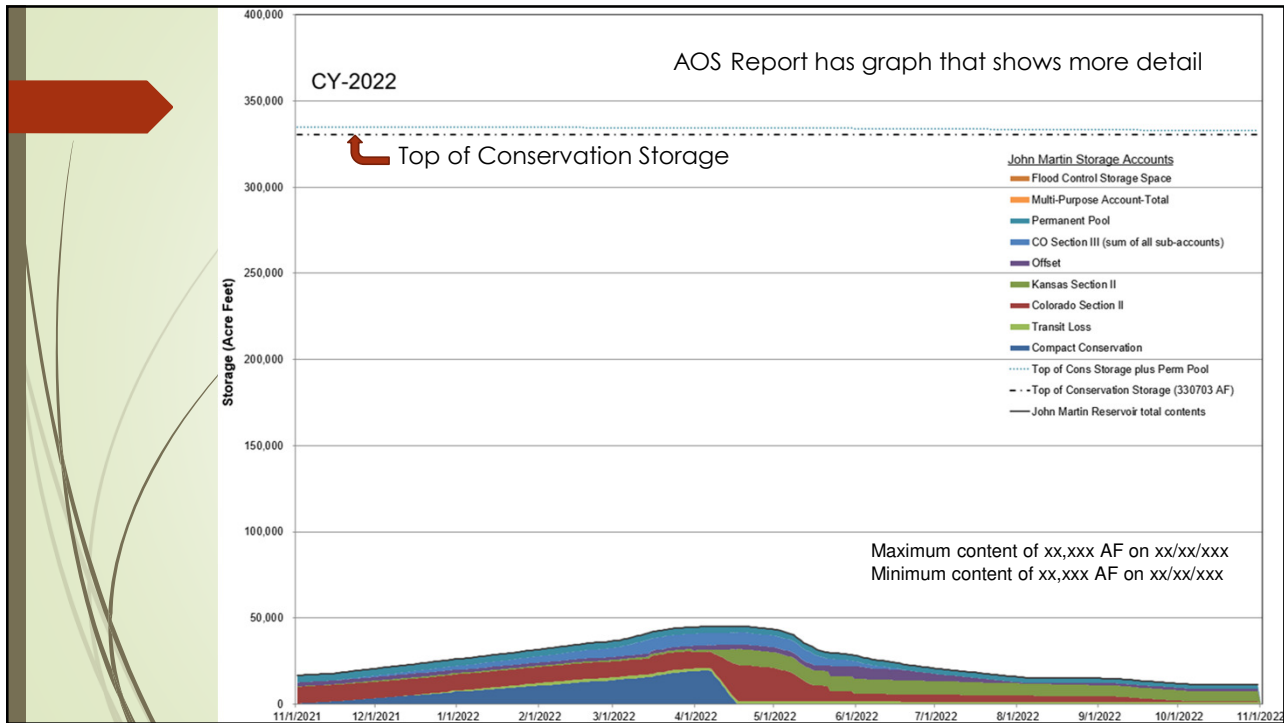

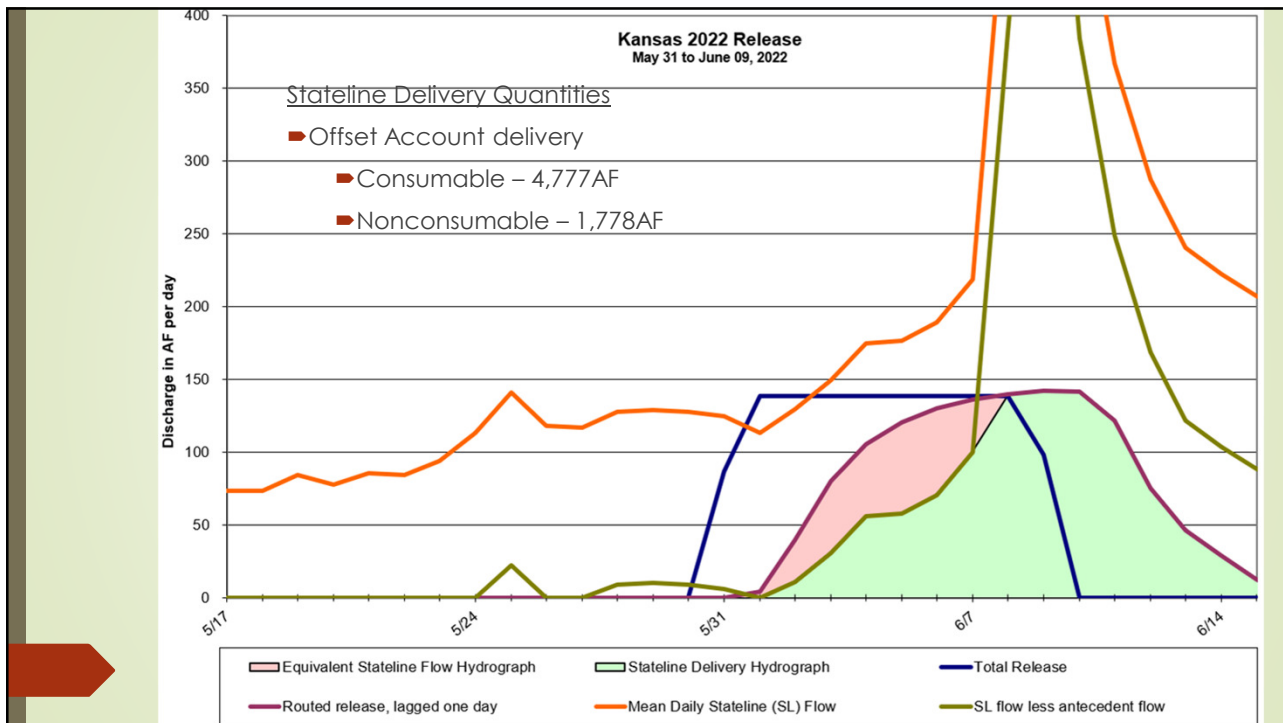

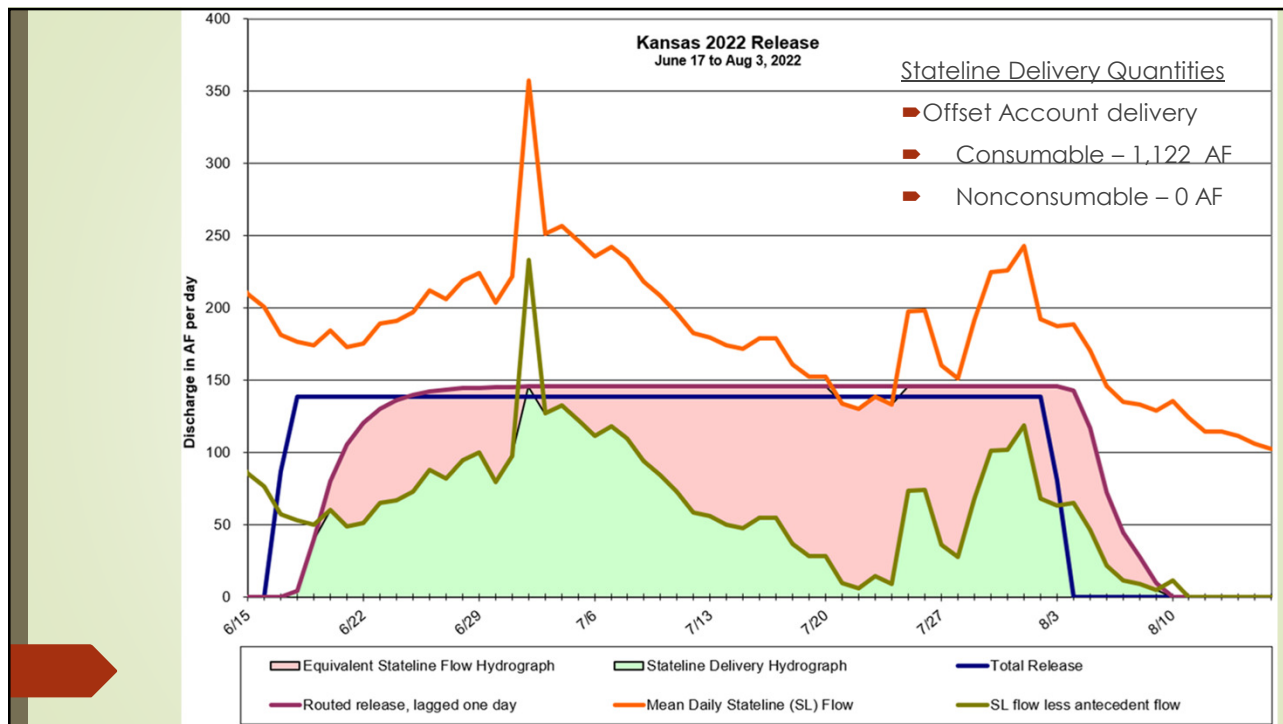
## 2022 AOS Report

- Kansas had two Offset Account releases
  - First release from 5/31 to 6/9/2022
  - Second release 6/17 to 8/3/2022
  - States agreed to release accounting
  - Still need to review how target flow at Granada is determined
- Focused on keeping Offset Account fully released
- Shortall transit loss is still in dispute


