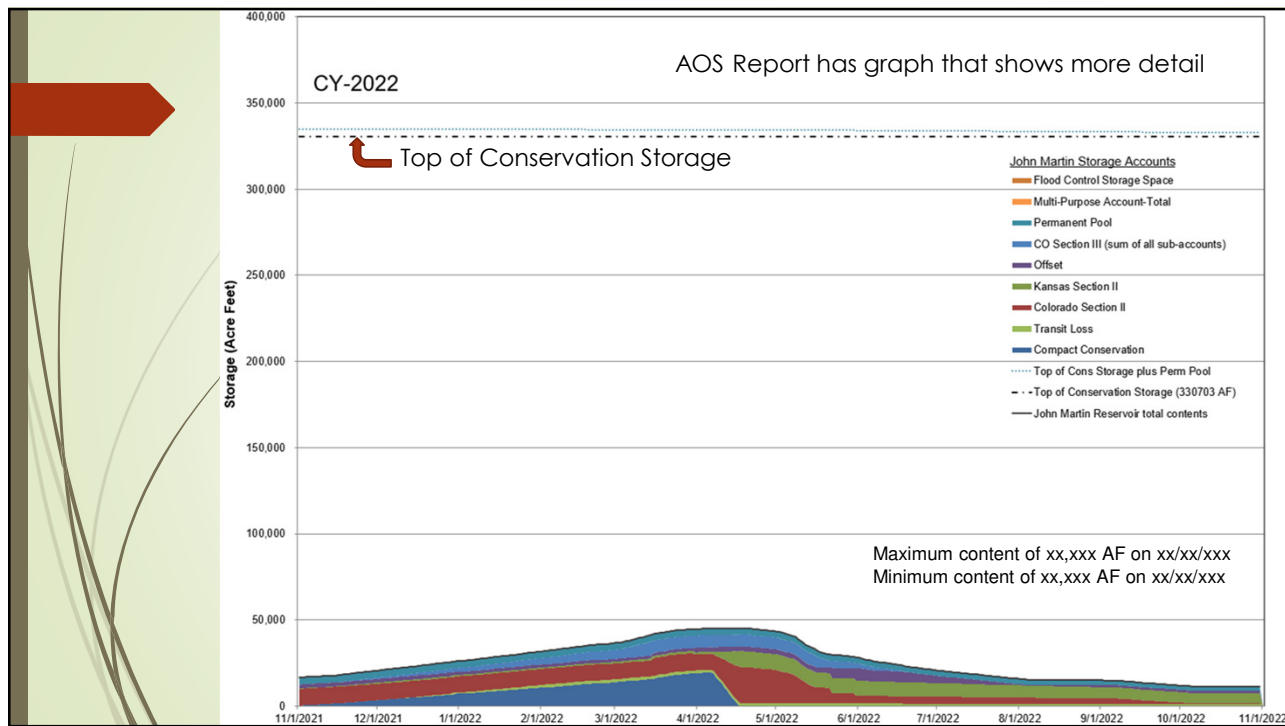

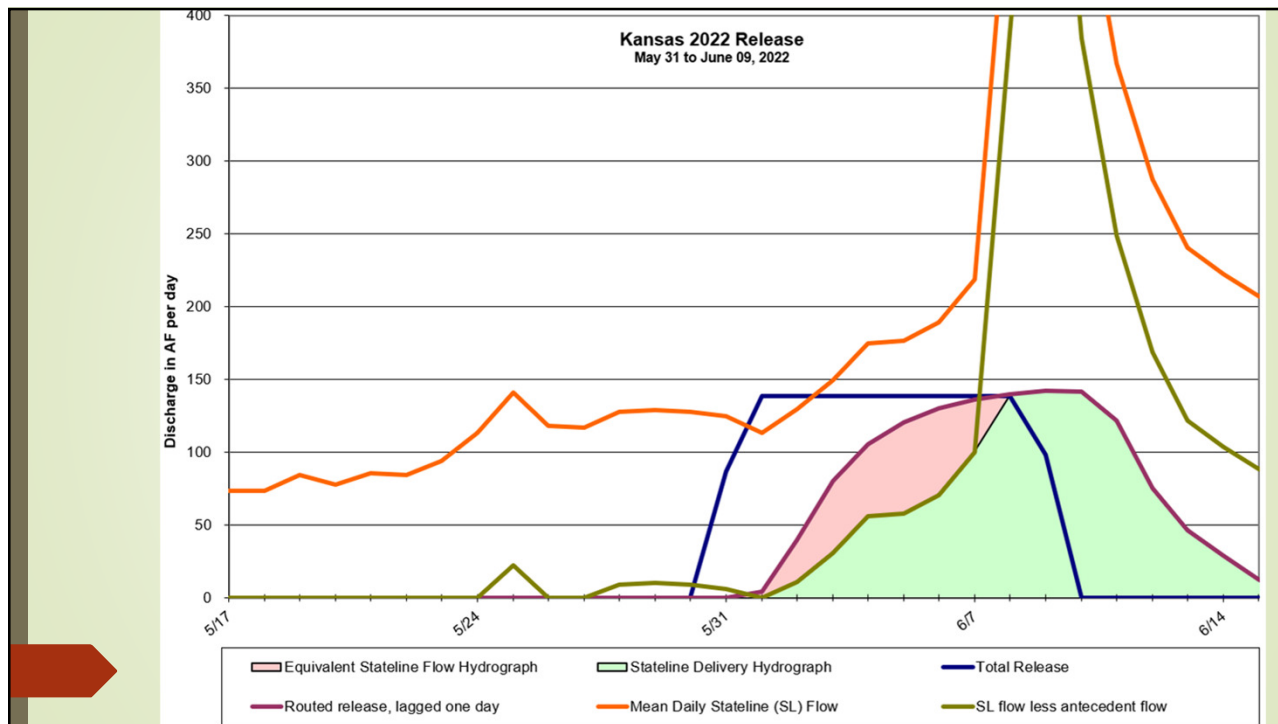

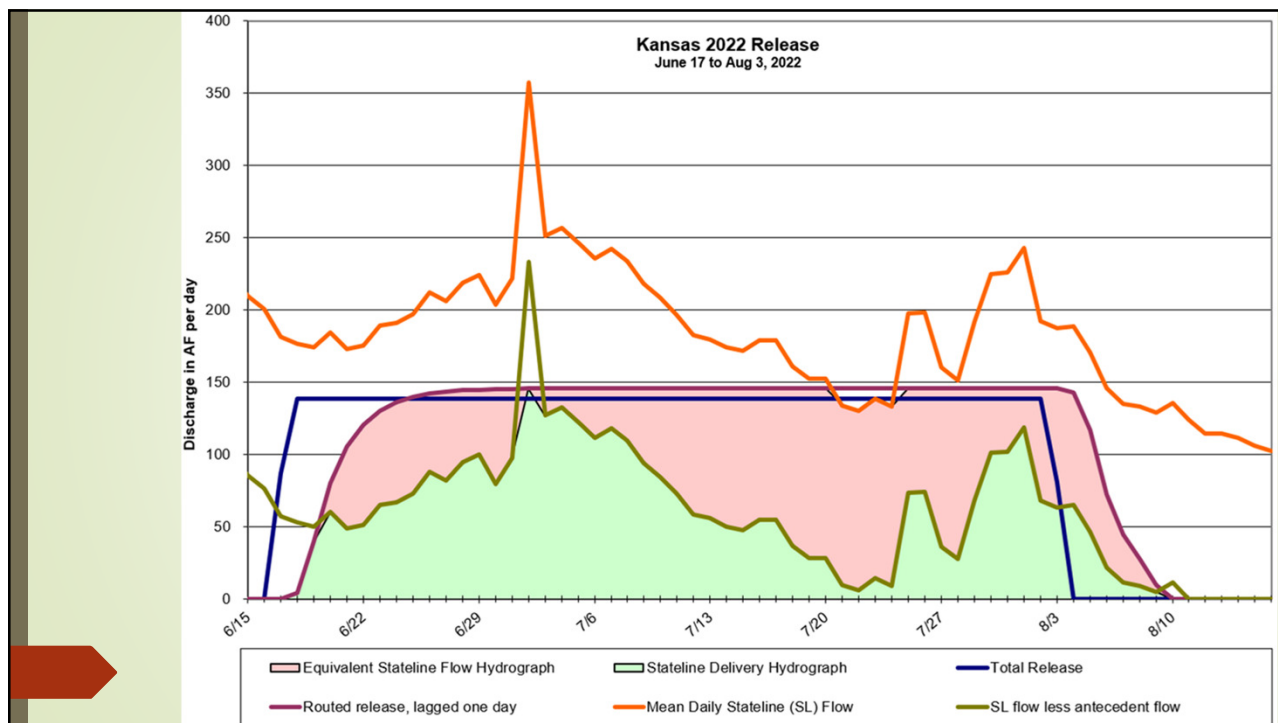
2022 AOS Report
